## **Clinical Trials Operational Planning Update**

The Transformation Team continues to meet weekly to discuss key decisions regarding Step 1 of the CTO Planning Initiative. Several decisions have been made as an outcome of these meetings:

- The YCC CTO will implement "Career Ladders" for multiple clinical operations positions.
   Career Ladders will provide additional career advancement opportunities within the CTO, as well as increase workforce stability. The ladders themselves are currently in design and more details will be announced in the coming months.
- The Steering Committee has approved the creation of support role(s) to assist YCC investigators with the development of Investigator Initiated Trials (IITs). IITs are essential to YCC and our research mission, and by providing dedicated resource(s) we can help you in this important area. Additional information to come!
- The membership for the Step 1 Advisory Team has been finalized. This Advisory Team will review approved materials and provide feedback on the design and implementation plans from a community stakeholder standpoint.
