

What to Expect at Your EEG Visit



The day before your visit, one of our team members will call you to talk to you about your visit. You will sign a form if this is OK with you.



Everyone in our study gets assigned their own *special number*, so your name will never be used in our research.

On the day of your visit, you will meet us at the McPartland Lab on the 6th floor of the Temple Medical Center.



You will go over what will happen during your visit once more and ask any questions you have before signing a form.



You will play some games!



We will take you to the lab. You will watch the screen as we measure your brain waves.



We will wear gloves during this part to help keep you safe and healthy.



We will measure your brain waves with this special hat.



We will measure your head to figure out the right size.



We will cover you with a cape so you stay dry. Then, we will put the hat on your head. It will be a little wet.



We will wiggle the parts of the hat and add a little water or gel to make sure it fits well.

You will watch pictures and videos on the screen.



One of our lab members might sit next to you while you watch.

Afterwards, we will take the net off your head, and you're all done!
