Supplement Clinic

Our Supplement Clinic provides an opportunity for patients to have an open discussion with our Oncology Dietitian, Integrative Medicine Physician, and Oncology Pharmacist regarding supplements, vitamins, and herbs they may be taking. The goal of our Supplement Clinic is to guide our patients on making informed decisions regarding supplements and ensure these supplements offer benefits to their health and well-being while avoiding unnecessary risk to their cancer treatment and prognosis.

Integrative medicine reaffirms the importance of the relationship between practitioner and patient, focuses on the whole person, is informed by evidence, and makes use of all appropriate therapeutic, lifestyle approaches, and healthcare disciplines to achieve optimal health and healing.

Patients can self-refer to the Integrative Medicine team, or they may access the Integrative Medicine team by a referral from clinical teams. The Integrative Medicine team sees patients at Smilow Cancer Hospital in New Haven, in addition to select Smilow locations.
