Prospective study of sleep disorders, neurodegenerative diseases, and diabetes

The worldwide prevalence and incidence of chronic noncommunicable diseases, particularly neurologic diseases and diabetes, are increasing in pandemic proportions. Taking advantage of five ongoing cohorts in US and China including over 350,000 men and women, we thus have conducted several prospective studies to understand the potential risk factors and clinic consequences of these disorders. The current presentation will include three sections: common sleep disorders (ie, restless legs syndrome and insomnia), neurodegenerative disorders (Parkinson's disease and cognitive impairment) and diabetes.
