
"The Course" 4th Annual Harvard vs Yale: Cases and Controversies in Endoscopy

The field of endoscopy has rapidly evolved with the introduction of innovative diagnostic techniques and novel therapeutics. The endoscopist now frequently encounters difficult issues and controversies in patient management. This program is designed to take a case-based and endoscopic video approach to understand the current role of endoscopy in the care of patients with a variety of gastrointestinal diseases. Major challenging topics will be explored including the basics of endoscopy, innovations in upper and lower GI disorders, gastrointestinal bleeding, and pancreas and biliary tract disorders.
