“Zoonoses and Anthroponoses: The Role of Veterinarians in One Health”

It is well known that the spillover of disease from wildlife to humans can result in disastrous consequences to public health and economic welfare. As the human-wildlife interface increases due to pressures on nature, the opportunity for disease transmission increases. In reverse, these same drivers lead to an increased risk of disease transmission from humans to wildlife, with the potential to extirpate species. Veterinary researchers working at the animal-human interface use a One Health approach that focuses on disease mitigation for *both* wildlife and humans.
