She received her M.D. from Stanford University School of Medicine and completed her clinical training in Internal Medicine and Hematology-Oncology at the Brigham and Women's Hospital and Dana-Farber Cancer Institute in Boston, MA. She joined the staff at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute in 2000. Her research program at DFCI has consistently focused on addressing a fundamental feature of cancer: its genomic heterogeneity—providing a means to evolve, adapt and escape from immune control.
