Ambulatory Update

The Smilow Ambulatory Transformation Team has updated their scheduling guidelines for providers. In sites where physical space allows for appropriate patient flow at screening, safe distancing in waiting areas, and prompt rooming, up to 3 patients per hour (12 per clinic session) may be scheduled per Yale Medicine/YNHHS guidelines. Please review this new guideline with nursing and administrative leads in your clinic to plan escalation of scheduling, as feasible.
