Dr. Rahmatullah Rahmati has been appointed an Assistant Professor in the Section of Otolaryngology at Yale School of Medicine and cares for patients at both Smilow Cancer Hospital and The Veterans Affairs (VA) Comprehensive Cancer Center in West Haven. Dr. Rahmati received his Medical Degree from the University of Sydney in Australia, and his Master of Public Health from Columbia University. His residency in Otolaryngology was completed at NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital/Weill Cornell Medical Center and his fellowship in Head and Neck Surgical Oncology at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center. Previously, he was an Assistant Professor at NewYork-Presbyterian/Columbia University Medical Center in their Department of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery.

Dr. Rahmati's clinical expertise is in treating benign and malignant tumors of the head and neck region and minimally invasive surgical removal of tumors. His research interests encompass areas of head and neck cancers, salivary gland disorders, and obstructive sleep apnea.
