“Understanding Nutrition/Infection Interactions: A Case Study of Nutrition and Hookworm Infection in rural Ghana”

Dr. Humphries will provide an introduction to key issues in understanding interactions between nutrition infections, with a particular focus on helminth infections. Soil transmitted helminth infections are a neglected tropical disease, with a high global prevalence, and often co-occur with malnutrition. Understanding the role of nutritional status and exposure in susceptibility to helminth infection could provide long term approaches to sustainable control of soil transmitted helminth infections.
