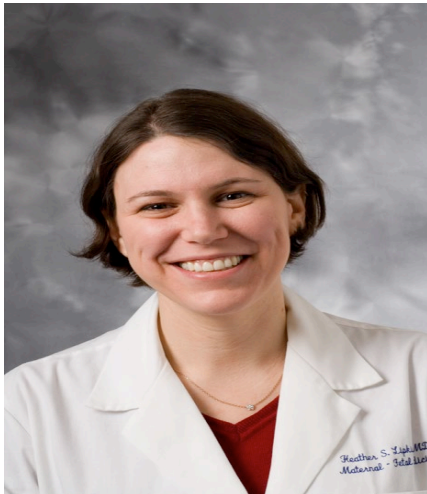

Heather Lipkind, MD, MS is the Director of Maternal Fetal of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Weill Cornell Medicine. She completed her residency in OB/GYN at New York University. She completed her Maternal-fetal Medicine fellowship at Columbia University in 2006 and her Master’s in Clinical Epidemiology from the Mailman School of Public Health during her Fellowship. Dr. Lipkind was previously a Professor and the Fellowship Director and a Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Yale University until she returned to NYC in October of 2022. Dr. Lipkind is a consultant for the CDC’s Vaccine Safety Datalink Team at Health Partners Research Foundation and has been actively involved in study design, interpretation of findings and manuscript preparation on ongoing studies of vaccine safety during pregnancy for the CDC. She has worked on several projects examining the association of Pregnancy-related health conditions with long-term health outcomes with a focus on hypertension, preeclampsia and cardiovascular disease and vaccine safety.
