Yin Cao, ScD, MPH, is a cancer epidemiologist and Associate Professor of Surgery in the Department of Surgery, Division of Public Health Sciences, at Washington University School of Medicine in St Louis. She was trained in biology, economics, and molecular/nutritional/clinical epidemiology. She received her MPH from Columbia University and ScD from Harvard University. Her ongoing work incorporates high-throughput technologies into large-scale collaborative epidemiological/clinical studies to investigate the etiology and emerging risk factors for early-onset cancers throughout the life course, with a particular focus on colorectal cancer (<u>https://caolab.wustl.edu/</u>). She has also been interested in developing personalized screening strategies for younger adults using microsimulation modeling.
