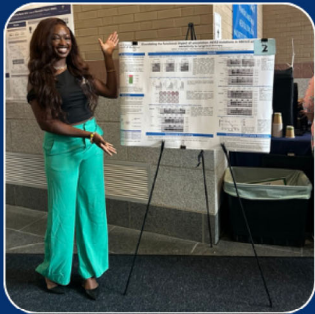


Yale Cancer Center Ninth Annual Trainee Colloquium
