A Smilow technology review committee has been created to triage technology initiatives for prioritization, workflow, and sustainability. DaVinci Xi Surgical System at Westerly Hospital

Westerly Hospital expanded its surgical capabilities with the acquisition of the da Vinci Xi Surgical System. The robotic device arrived at the hospital last week and surgeons will perform the first urologic procedures next month to treat urologic cancers, prostate enlargement, male infertility, and kidney stone management. In addition, the new technology

will be utilized for hysterectomies as well as thyroid cancer removal, colorectal procedures, and hernia repair.

Director for the Ambulatory Practice


