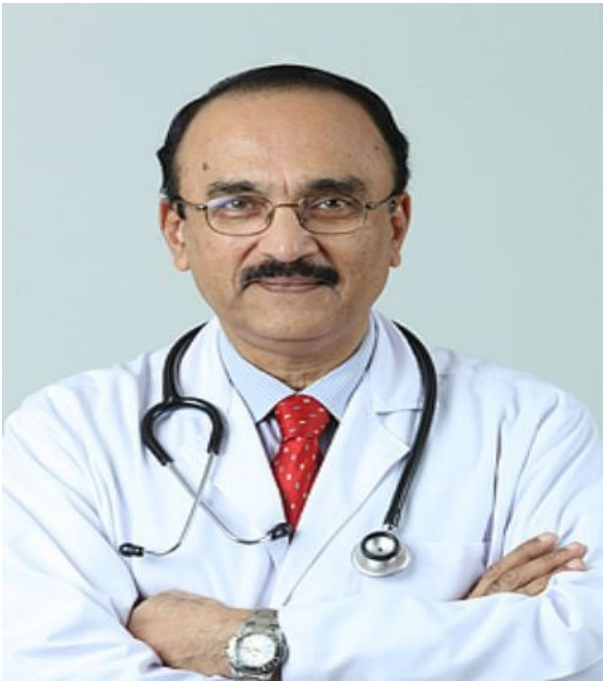

Professor B.S. Ramakrishna MBBS, MD, DM, PhD, is presently Director of the Institute of Gastroenterology at SIMS Hospital, Chennai, India and Professor of Medicine (Adjunct), Yale University. Prior to 2013 Prof. Ramakrishna's career has been primarily at Christian Medical College, Vellore (CMC-Vellore) where he was Professor of Gastroenterology and Head of the Division of Gastrointestinal Sciences. Among his many professional honors and activities Prof. Ramakrishna was Editor-in-Chief, Indian Journal of Gastroenterology (2012-2017) and President of Indian Society of Gastroenterology (2011-2012).

Prof. Ramakrishna's research has been directed toward various aspects of small and large intestinal function in health and disease with particular emphasis on the etiology and treatment of diarrhea in tropical countries. Prof. Ramakrishna has published more than 160 publications as well as the Chapter on Tropical Diarrhea and Malabsorption in the last three editions of Sleisenger & Fordtran's Textbook of Gastrointestinal and Liver Disease.
