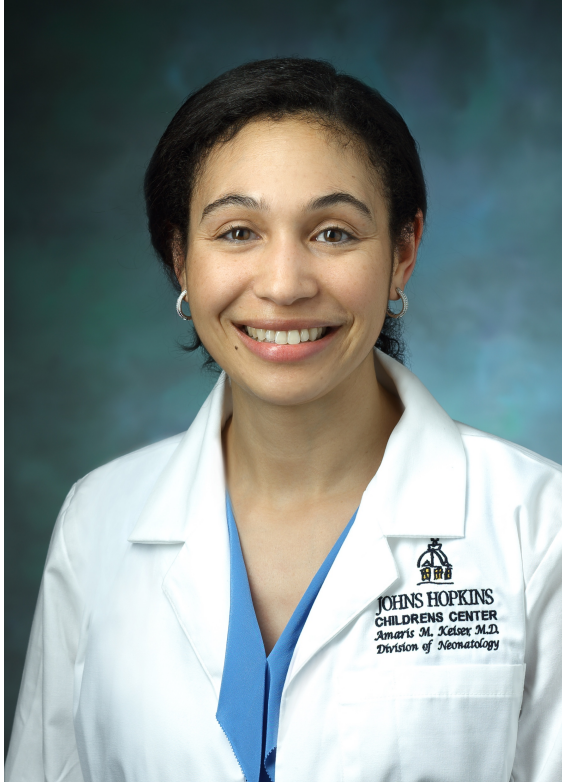

Disparities in Maternal and Neonatal Outcomes by Race/Ethnicity

Compared to their white peers, Black, Hispanic, American Indian and Alaska Native women are two to three times more likely to experience adverse maternal and neonatal pregnancy outcomes, including preterm birth, low birth weight and maternal or neonatal mortality. This talk will explore the literature informing these statistics, its evolution over time, and the hypotheses developed to begin to understand why these disparities exist and persist.
