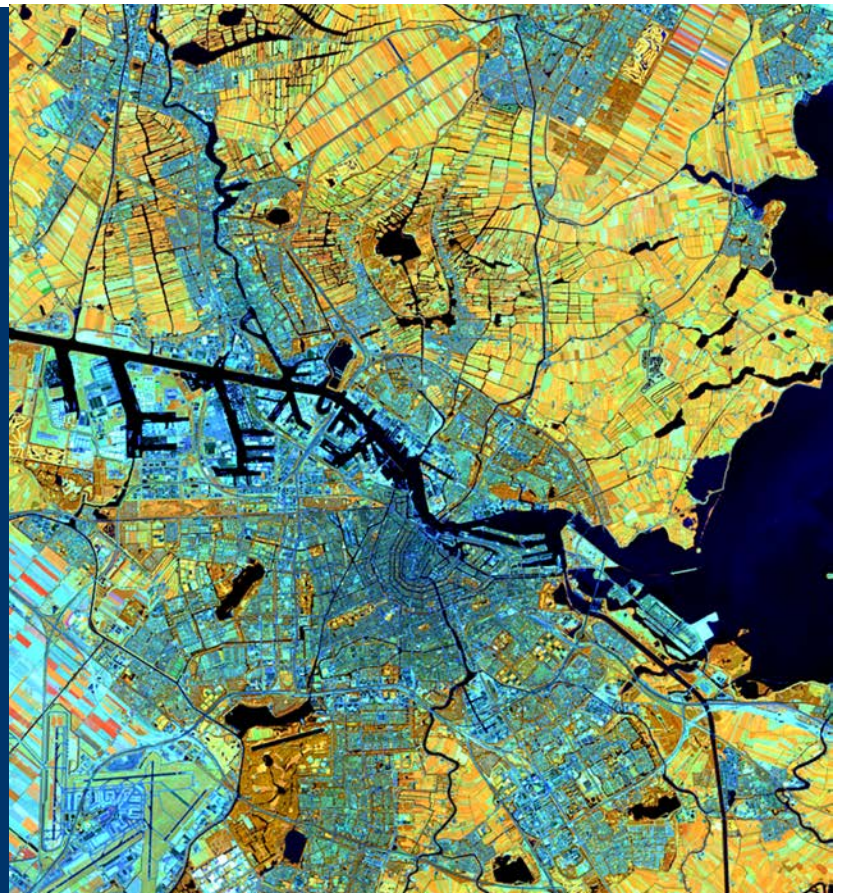


Hixon Center Urban Conference
