

# **Biannual Media Report** January - June 2024

The Yale School of Public Health was mentioned in approximately 5,600 news clips between Jan. 1 and June 30, 2024, which represents a 5.6% increase in mentions over the same period in 2023. The media coverage had a potential reach of approximately 50 million people with a publicity value of approximately \$14 million, according to Cision marketing communications software.
