From New York City, New Haven and West:

Interstate 95 North to Connecticut Exit 65. Take a right turn at exit ramp light to second stop light in center of town. Turn left onto Route 1 East (Boston Post Road). Go up about half a mile. Water’s Edge entrance will be on your right. From NYC, approximately 100 miles and two hours driving time.

From Hartford, Springfield and North:

Interstate 91 South or I-84 West to Hartford. From Hartford, take I- 91 South to Route 9. Then take Route 9 South to Exit 3. Go through exit stop sign to second stop sign. Turn right onto Route 153 South and follow to the end of route until intersection with Route 1 in Westbrook. At light, turn left onto Route 1 East (Boston Post Road). Go up about half a mile. Water’s Edge entrance will be on your right. From Hartford, approximately 50 miles and an hour driving time.

From Boston, Providence and East

Interstate 95 South to Connecticut Exit 65. Left turn at the exit ramp to the third stop light in the center of Westbrook. Left turn at light onto Route 1 East (Boston Post Road). Go up about half a mile. Water’s Edge entrance will be on your right. From Boston, approximately 129 miles and two and a half hours driving time.
