Care Centers

Ambulatory care in our 15 Care Centers has quickly moved to Telehealth appointments, when possible, and is consolidating between some Centers. The temporary closures are to conserve critical resources and to keep our staff and patients well and safe. The close-knit community in each of our Care Centers has provided the opportunity for many of our staff members to personally reach out to our patients directly to help alleviate their anxiety and walk them through Telehealth, office transitions, and personal concerns.

- **Old Saybrook** temporarily closed and merged with Guilford
- **Fairfield** will temporarily close on April 3 and merge with Trumbull
- **Orange** will temporarily close on April 10 and merge with Derby

Radiology

YNHHS is transitioning to advance scheduling for all imaging tests, including X-rays. Walk-in appointments will not be accepted. In addition, a Radiology COVID-19 hotline has been set up at 475-246-9660 and will be available daily from 7am to 7pm. The Radiology & Biomedical Imaging Office at 2560 Dixwell Avenue in Hamden will exclusively serve patients who are COVID-19-positive or suspected to be.

The Yale Cancer Center leadership is inspired by the incredible response from our membership for proposals to stimulate research on the novel coronavirus. With just over a day's notice, over 30 applications were submitted for internal review. A review committee of 14 people from the Cancer Center evaluated the submissions and selected two final proposals for submission to the NCI.
