As leaders in women's health, the Department of Obstetrics, Gynecology, and Reproductive Sciences at Yale School of Medicine consists of thinkers, creators, visionaries, and doers who advance the field through clinical excellence, innovative education, and groundbreaking research.

Yale Ob/Gyn's strong commitment and teamwork helped us through 2025. It was a year of growth, change, and challenges.

CLINICAL

We believe the most innovative clinical care is also the most compassionate. That has been a founding core principle. Yale Ob/Gyn was once again recognized as one of the best obstetrics and gynecology



departments in the world. In its 2025 edition, *Newsweek* ranked us #10 worldwide, one of only four U.S. institutions in the top 10. We strategically added to Yale Ob/Gyn's faculty family, growing in nearly every division. Two new gynecologic oncologists joined the team, as well as two new gynecologic specialists; three additional maternal-fetal medicine experts came on board; one urogynecologist was recruited; one faculty member was hired to split their time between complex family planning and obstetric specialties & midwifery, and three additional new faculty members were dedicated to obstetric specialties &

midwifery. Each addition strengthens Yale Ob/Gyn's ability to provide comprehensive, advanced care while maintaining the highest standards in women's health. As we continue serving as a beacon for patients, our clinical teams remain focused on pushing boundaries and delivering exceptional outcomes.

EDUCATION & TRAINING

The department has produced more leaders in obstetrics and gynecology than any other institution worldwide. This is a testament to Yale Ob/Gyn's educational excellence. We are committed to instilling the next generation with a sense of service, mission, and resilience that keeps academic medicine relevant and impactful. We deliberately emphasize both clinical competence and the visionary thinking needed to shape the future of reproductive health. Through mentorship, hands-on training, and exposure to cutting-edge research, we prepare trainees to become tomorrow's change agents. Whether through our



residency programs, fellowship training, or continuing medical education initiatives, we remain dedicated to developing leaders who will carry forward Yale Ob/Gyn's mission of advancing women's health globally.

RESEARCH

The department's research achievements demonstrate our tremendous global influence and scholarly excellence. In 2025, ScholarGPS (a comprehensive scholarly analytics platform) ranked Yale Ob/Gyn No. 1 worldwide for lifetime achievement in publications and citations—objective recognition that we are the most impactful obstetrics and gynecology department of all time. Yale Ob/Gyn's research spans the spectrum from basic science to clinical trials, addressing critical questions in reproductive health, maternal medicine, gynecologic oncology, and fertility preservation.
