HISTORY

- MR is a 41 year-old female with a history of anemia who presented to the ED with a pneumonia. In addition to usual pneumonia symptoms, she also complained about a sensation that her chest being squeezed.
- PMH: anemia
- FH: mother had hereditary kidney disease, was on dialysis, and passed away

Differential diagnosis


- VHL disease (pancreatic cysts)
- Primary renal disease-related cysts
- Multiple incidental renal cysts
- ARPKD (enlarged kidney, cysts numerous & small, childhood onset, corticomedullary differentiation loss)
- Medullary cyst disease
- Multicystic dysplastic kidney (unilateral, non-heraditary)

Bosniak classification system of renal cystic masses

- Septa and Calcification
- Bosniak 1: simple ~0% malignant
- Bosniak 2: minimally complex ~0-5% malignant
- Bosniak 3: intermediate ~50% malignant
- Bosniak 4: clearly malignant, solid

Autosomal-dominant polycystic kidney disease

- Incidence of 1 in 1000, and 5% of ESRD
- Polycystin 1 (16p, 85%) and 2 (4q, 15%), involved in tubular epithelial cell adhesion and as an ion channel, repsectively
- Progressive dilation and dysfunction of renal tubules



Clinical presentation

- Flank or abdominal pain
- Hematuria
- Hypertension

• Higher risk for pyelonephritis, urinary calculi, vascular sclerosis

Extrarenal manifestations

- Hepatic cysts with preserved liver function
- Pancreatic and intestinal cysts, colonic diverticula, inguinal/abdominal hernia
- Valvular heart disorders
- Aneurysm: cerebral artery and carotid artery

Management

- Symptomatic management
- Strict control of hypertension
- Screening for cerebral aneurysm
- Dialysis and transplantation
