“Identifying Patient Preferences for Diabetes Care in Samoa: Piloting and Implementing a Discrete Choice Experiment”

This talk will discuss chronic disease prevalence in Samoa, with a special focus on type 2 diabetes. I will outline our recent work examining type 2 diabetes care cascade engagement in Samoan adults and the losses that were identified; (2) discuss my current and ongoing work centered around constructing and implementing a discrete choice experiment. This innovative method aims to identify patient-preferred diabetes care attributes that can be incorporated into diabetes management and intervention strategies and hopefully be more effective at retaining individuals in care.
