NEEDS ASSESSMENT:

The practice of gestational surrogacy for family building in the United States and internationally continues to rise. Extreme vulnerability and complexity associated with gestational surrogacy requires compassionate and coordinated care planning. Recent experiences exposed a recognizable need for education and discussion related to Yale New Haven Hospital preparation and practices. This Grand Rounds will review state of gestational carrier arrangements, preparation processes and facility practices- all efforts to support the healthcare team caring for the families involved in gestational carrier arrangements.
