# **"Donor Kidney Quality and Acute Kidney Injury with Transplantation"**

## NEEDS ASSESSMENT:

Kidney transplantation is the best long-term treatment for end-stage renal disease. Clinicians need to identify patients who are potential candidates for kidney donation. They therefore need to understand factors that affect donor kidney quality.
