Smilow Quality Metrics and Key Stats:

- Whipple procedure length of stay is in the top 8th percentile in the U.S.*
 - Pancreatic fistula rate is top 25th percentile in the U.S.*
 - Delayed gastric emptying is top 15th percentile in the U.S.*
 - Majority of patients undergoing surgery are scheduled for a minimally invasive approach for hepato-pancreato-biliary and gastric surgeries
- 45 clinical trials available for patients with gastrointestinal cancers and melanoma, including adoptive T cell therapy, through Yale Cancer Center, the only National Cancer Institute-designated Comprehensive Cancer Center in Connecticut and one of only 51 in the U.S.
