"Measles in Space and Time"

Apart from its great public health importance, measles is a poster child for spatio-temporal epidemic dynamics. We review the history of research on measles dynamics, which is deeply rooted in Dr. Black's work. We then describe recent work on the dynamic forces that drive the rich diversity of measles incidence patterns in different epidemiological settings. The lecture concludes with a discussion of measles control, with a special focus on the impact of vaccine refusal on local elimination.
