Electronic Signatures	Clarify that a document with a placed signature was signed using eReg by including the text "in Advarra eRegulatory."		
Reports	Allow the Missing Protocol Documents report and the Electronic Signature Status for Protocol Documents report to be run for multiple protocols at a time.		
Reports	Include participating site information in the Expiring Protocol Documents and Document Upload Details reports.
