“Improving Post-ICU Outcomes: A Call to Action”

NEEDS ASSESSMENT:

Post-ICU Syndrome is common among patients who survive critical illness requiring intensive care. Clinicians need to know about the manifestations of post-ICU syndrome, understand why it is of particular concern in older patients, and have knowledge of interventions for improving post-ICU outcomes.
