# Robert L. Camp MD PhD

Department of Pathology Yale School of Medicine

Dr. Camp is an Associate Research Scientist in the Department of Pathology at Yale University School of Medicine. After completing a Ph.D. in Immunology at Rockefeller University, he earned his M.D. from Yale School of Medicine, where he also completed his residency in Pathology. His research has focused on developing automated, quantitative methods for biomarker analysis in tissue specimens. Dr. Camp has a strong interest in using emerging technologies—such as web-based platforms, AI, and QR codes—to create a more interactive learning environment for students and instructors. Clinically, he serves with the Yale Autopsy Service and teaches immunology and pathology to Yale medical and physician associate students.
