

Glossary of Terms



Password: a secret word or phrase used to protect your online account.



Username: a unique name used to access your online account.



Settings: Also called preferences, tools or options – let's you adjust how the software or your device behaves.



Browser: the software program that allows you to access the internet.



Address bar/URL: the text field at the top of the browser window.



Attachment: a file sent with an email message. Can be a photo, document, movie or sound file.



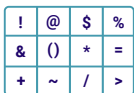
Upload: sending a file (like a photo or document) from your smartphone or computer to a website or other person over the internet.



Download: receiving a file from the internet onto your smartphone or computer.



Submit: a button that you click to send information through the internet.



Character: any letter or symbol (including punctuation and numbers) on the smartphone or computer keyboard.



Enable: allow a feature or function.



Disable: no longer allow a feature or function.



Backspace key: deletes or erases the characters on the screen just to the left of the cursor.



Back Arrow key: usually takes you back to the previous screen or website page.



Delete key: deletes selected (or highlighted) items of the characters to the right of the cursor.



@ sign key: a required part of any email address that identifies where the email will be sent
