BIO: Marianthi-Anna Kioumourtzoglou is an environmental engineer and epidemiologist. She holds an MSPH from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and a DSc in Environmental Health from the Harvard TH Chan School of Public Health. She is currently an Assistant Professor at the Department of Environmental Health Sciences at the Columbia University Mailman School of Public Health. Her research focuses on two main themes. She studies the effects of air pollution exposures on adverse health, with a special emphasis on neurological outcomes, from neurodevelopment to neurodegeneration and mood disorders. She is also very interested in developing and applying methods for environmental epidemiology, from quantification and correction of exposure measurement error, to incorporating exposures to complicated environmental mixtures in health studies, and novel study designs.
