## EFT<sup>®</sup> Quick Guide

- Urine LH surge = cycle day 13; ovulation and the first FULL day of P = cycle day 14.
- Always perform at least a cycle day 24 biopsy. If doing a mock cycle, try to also do a day 15 biopsy.
- If repeating the EFT<sup>®</sup>, please contact the lab or Dr. Kliman for customized instructions.
- Perform a standard endometrial biopsy (Pipelle, Milex Uterine Explora Model I Curette, etc.). \*\*\*Cut tip of Pipelle or curette off before ejecting tissue into 10% neutral buffered formalin\*\*\*
- Fill out and sign the *Request for Endometrial Function Test*<sup>®</sup> (*EFT*<sup>®</sup>) form. Include a money order or cashier's check for \$595 made payable to Yale University. Visa and MC are now also accepted. Please note that we will not be able to process any EFTs without both payment and patient signed HIPAA and EFT Request forms.
