Serous Fluid Cytopathology*

**Needs:** The International system developed by the American Society of Cytopathology and the International Academy of Cytology is the first concerted effort of the cytopathology community to develop a system that will improve communication of these reports between pathologists and other physicians.

**Objectives:** To learn the rationale for a reporting system for serous fluids; to learn the diagnostic criteria of the different diagnostic categories; and to plan research and audit projects on the subject in their institutions.
