"The Epicentre Response to High Burden of Infectious Diseases in Southwestern Uganda"

Uganda has the highest malaria incidence in the world and is ranked the 16th country in prevalence of tuberculosis (TB). The rural areas like Mbarara district bear the brunt of the diseases.
