

Echezona E. Ezeanolue, MD, MPH, FAAP, FIDSA is currently Vice-President, HealthySunrise Foundation, Professor of Pediatrics and Director, Center for Translation and Implementation Research at the University of Nigeria. He is an infectious disease specialist and clinical epidemiologist with an extensive record of population-based research focused on the use of implementation science to enhance the quality, effectiveness, and outcomes of health services and achieve health equity. He has served as PI on multiple federal grants, including a HRSA-funded comprehensive maternal-child HIV program and NIH-funded research grants. He has served on multiple national committees, including the Advisory Committee for Immunization Practices (20015-2019), the American Academy of Pediatrics Committee on Pediatric AIDS (2015-2019), an NIH study section (2015-2018), and the Patient Centered Outcome Research Institute (2012-2015). Dr Ezeanolue leads the Nigeria Implementation Science Alliance and has been recognized as Nevada Public Health Leader of the Year (2007), Nevada Health Care Hero (2008), Nevada Immunization Champion (2009), Outstanding Research Mentor (2009), and American Academy of Pediatrics Local Hero (2010) for his contributions to public health.
