 - Supervision and precepting in the HIV clinic
 - Teaching on ward rounds including physical diagnosis rounds
 - Facilitate students' shadowing of local doctors in TB wards, HIV clinic, Emergency room, Surgical ward
 - Conducting formal didactic session weekly on variety of clinical topics
 - Oversee development of powerpoint presentations for lectures to South African physicians and auxiliary staff
