Hecht Global Health Faculty Network Award

Amount: Up to \$50,000

Eligibility

The Hecht Global Health Faculty Network Award promotes new research and programs in global health undertaken by YIGH Faculty Networks. To be eligible, proposals should include all of the following: faculty affiliated with at least one YIGH Faculty Network, faculty with primary appointments in at least two different schools at Yale University, a student and/or trainee engagement with the project, and a clear linkage to future external funding opportunities to support the proposed initiative.

Review Process

- Complete applications will be reviewed by a panel of YIGH-affiliated faculty and include both
 quantitative and qualitative assessment. Efforts will be made to avoid conflicts of interest (COI)
 in the review process.
- Review committee members will review and score applications independently. Applications submitted past the deadline will not be considered. All funding decisions are final.

Additional Information

- YIGH offers an information session prior to the award deadline. Potential applicants are strongly
 encouraged to attend, although attendance at the info session is not required for proposal
 submission/review.
- We encourage applicants who were not funded in a given round or who were unable to submit by the deadline to consider resubmitting in the next round.
- It is not necessary to cover faculty/PI effort in the budget. This award funds direct costs only.
