Obesity and Cancer: How Can We Break the Link?

Needs: *There is a clear association between obesity and multiple forms of cancer, but mechanistic studies have been lacking.*

Objectives: *Describe the association between hyperinsulinemia and obesity in murine models of colon and breast cancer and identify the metabolic mechanism by which insulin appears to drive tumor growth in the models presented.*

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
